To Regulated Businesses:

The Hazardous Materials Division of Stanislaus County Department of Environmental Resources (DER) wants you to be aware that the aboveground storage tank laws have changed. As of January 1, 2008, the CUPA's were vested with the responsibility and authority to implement the Aboveground Petroleum Storage Act (APSA), which is the set of laws that define the Aboveground Storage Tank (AST) program. Under the APSA, your business will now be regulated and inspected by your local Certified Unified Program Agency (CUPA). The reassignment of this program makes DER the primary point of contact for above ground tanks instead of the Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB).

Due to the fact that this is a new law, we realize there are many areas in which you will be asking for clarification when it comes to the interpretation of the APSA. Our goal is to educate and work with your business in order to implement the requirements of the APSA. To accomplish these goals, Stanislaus County will be offering a workshop that will be dedicated to helping your business navigate through the AST regulations. This workshop will be offered at two different days and times to help accommodate work schedules of various businesses and their employees. The workshops will be offered:

**August 25, 2009
9AM-12PM – Harvest Hall**

**August 26, 2009
4PM-7PM – Harvest Hall**

The presentation will identify and help clarify key requirements pertaining to Aboveground Storage Tanks and your facility. A question and answer period will follow the presentation. The Department of Environmental Resources believes industry participation is very important to the development of this program and encourages representatives and/or employees from your business to attend the workshop.

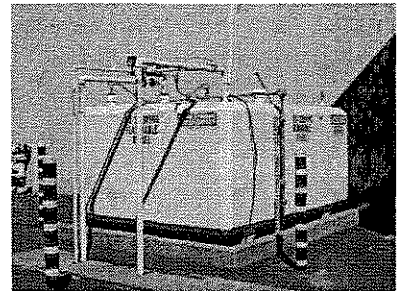
Stanislaus County will be offering an informational workshop to businesses to help you understand and prepare your facility for the changes ahead. Topics covered:
